



## **Chiann Bao**

Chiann Bao, a member of Arbitration Chambers, practices as an arbitrator and mediator and has served as tribunal chair, co-arbitrator, sole arbitrator, and emergency arbitrator in ad hoc arbitrations as well as institutional arbitrations under the ICC, UNCITRAL, SIAC, HKIAC, CIETAC, KCAB, and SCIA rules.

She has arbitrated disputes in a variety of sectors, including joint venture and shareholder disputes, energy and resources, agency and distributorship agreements, pharmaceuticals, and telecommunications, involving commercial parties, state-owned entities and states. Chiann currently serves as a Vice President of the ICC Court of Arbitration.

She is also the chair of the ICC Commission's Task Force on ADR and Arbitration and a member of the ICC's Belt and Road Commission. From 2010 to 2018, she served as the Secretary General of the HKIAC and was subsequently appointed as a Council Member of the HKIAC.

Chiann is a fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, a CEDR-accredited mediator, and an honorary senior fellow at the British Institute of International and Comparative Law.
