Justin Gleeson SC is a barrister practising at the Australian bar and an international arbitration practitioner. Between 2012 and 2016 he was the Solicitor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia and advised the Government on matters of international, constitutional and public law as well as leading the Australian legal team in proceedings in the ICJ and the PCA against Japan, Timor-Leste and Phillip Morris Asia.

Domestically, Justin has appeared as leading counsel in the High Court of Australia in almost 90 matters. He currently specialises in international law and arbitration, constitutional law and appellate law. His most recent appointments are as Presiding Arbitrator in an LCIA London Arbitration and as Sole Arbitrator in a dispute involving a foreign State.

Justin is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Law, a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and a Fellow of the Australian Centre for International Commercial Arbitration.
