Neil Kaplan CBE QC SBS has been a full-time practising arbitrator since 1995.

Called to the Bar of England and Wales in 1965, Mr. Kaplan has practised as a barrister, Principal Crown Counsel at the Hong Kong Attorney General's Chambers and served as a Judge of the Supreme Court of Hong Kong in charge of the Construction and Arbitration List.

From 1991 until 2004, he was Chairman of the HKIAC, and in 1999-2000 he was President of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. Since 1995, he has been a Council Member and now Governing Board Member of ICCA. In 2012-2016 he was a Member of the ICC International Court of Arbitration. He is a Chartered Arbitrator and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. Since 2017, Mr. Kaplan has been the president of the Court of the Mauritius Chamber of Commerce and Industry Arbitration and Mediation Centre.
