



## **Professor Janet Walker DRP, JD, DPhil (Oxon), C Arb**

Janet is an independent arbitrator with chambers at Arbitration Place, Toronto; Sydney Arbitration Chambers, Australia; and Int-Arb Arbitrators, London; and. Janet has served as sole arbitrator, co-arbitrator and chair in ICC, ICDR, DIAC, HKIAC, KCAB and SIAC-administered, and in ad hoc arbitrations in a variety of seats. Her matters range from construction, M&A, shareholder, intellectual property, pharma and environmental. She has a good working knowledge of Spanish and French.

Janet is Distinguished Professor of Law (and past associate dean) at Osgoode Hall Law School, a member of the Ontario Bar, and a licensed legal consultant of the New York State Bar. She authors Canada's main text on private international law, cited in more than 350 judgments. She is chair of ICC Canada, founding co-chair of CanArbWeek and a member of the Boards of CIArb Canada and the International Construction Law Association.
