

MITIGATING SOVEREIGN RISK IN INTERNATIONAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Contractors undertaking international construction projects may potentially take steps to secure the legal protections available in international investment treaties, including Bilateral Investment Treaties (**BITs**) and Free Trade Agreements (**FTAs**), in the event that the contractual remedies (in their contracts with Government entities or with private owners) against governmental interference in their projects prove to be inadequate.

This seminar will discuss how BITs and FTAs may make a difference in managing key risks in international construction projects, including risks of project termination, lack of access, permit denials, non-payment, and other interference.
